

## **HYGIENE-CONCEPT Sailing-Classics**

Dear Sailing-Friend,

**we look forward to welcoming you on board at KAIRÓS, CHRONOS and RHEA!**

On our small ships, on which a manageable group of guests stays in a 'bubble' mainly on deck and in the fresh air, we consider the risk of infection on board to be extremely low.

For the safety of all guests and crew members, we have developed the following hygiene concept:

### **Before boarding:**

Since almost all of our guests have now been vaccinated and there were enough opportunities to be vaccinated, we have adapted our hygiene concept. Since November 7th, 2021, boarding is only possible for those who have been **fully vaccinated or have recovered (2-G regulation)**. We strongly recommend getting boosters. Children over the age of 12 must also be vaccinated.

The **Digital COVID Certificate of the EU** is valid as proof of vaccination. Please send the PDF to our office no later than two weeks before departure. The captain needs the documents for clearing in and out. The certificate on the smartphone is usually not accepted on site.

Before boarding, every guest (8 years and older) receives a Hotgen Rapid Antigen **self-test**. Please be there by 5:30 p.m. so that all test results are available by boarding at 6:00 p.m.

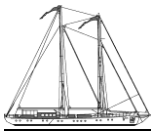
Boarding is only possible with a negative self-test. If a self-test is positive, a medical test must be carried out on land. If another COVID-19 test is planned for the same day (e.g. required for entering the next country), no self-test is required upon boarding.

Please disinfect your hands before entering the **dinghy**. Please wear a mask in the dinghy.

We are monitoring the situation and will adjust these regulations if necessary.

### **General hints on board:**

- Please bring your own mask with you and wash and disinfect your hands regularly.
- Please continue to observe the usual hygiene regulations even after a negative test.
- Disinfectants are available in all common areas. All door handles, railings, etc. are regularly disinfected. On the changeover day, all cabins, the saloon and the galley are disinfected.
- Please note the Sailing Classics COVID-19 posters.
- Cover your mouth and nose with a tissue when you cough or sneeze, or cough or sneeze into your elbow.
- Report to the captain if you show symptoms (fever, sore throat, cough, headache, loss of taste).



- The crew will inform you about local regulations before each shore leave. Please respect the local rules.
- If you do not wish to attend the weekly dinner ashore, you can dine on board.
- Should an infection nevertheless occur on board, there is a schedule for the crew.

## **Medical Tests:**

Most countries require a medical test for entry. Please inform yourself about the local regulations and also the regulations of your airline. The negative self-test is sufficient for boarding.

Additional PCR or antigen tests may be necessary during the trip due to changing local regulations. Sailing Classics has no influence on this or the costs of these tests. The crew will organize the tests. The personal contribution is max. € 200.00 per person and trip. If the costs are exceeded, Sailing-Classics will cover the difference.

If you need another negative test for the return journey, the crew will inform you as best as possible about the local conditions. However, each guest is responsible for the booking and organization. Please also note the requirements of your airline.

We are convinced that our guests and crew act responsibly and **wish you all a beautiful stay on board!**
